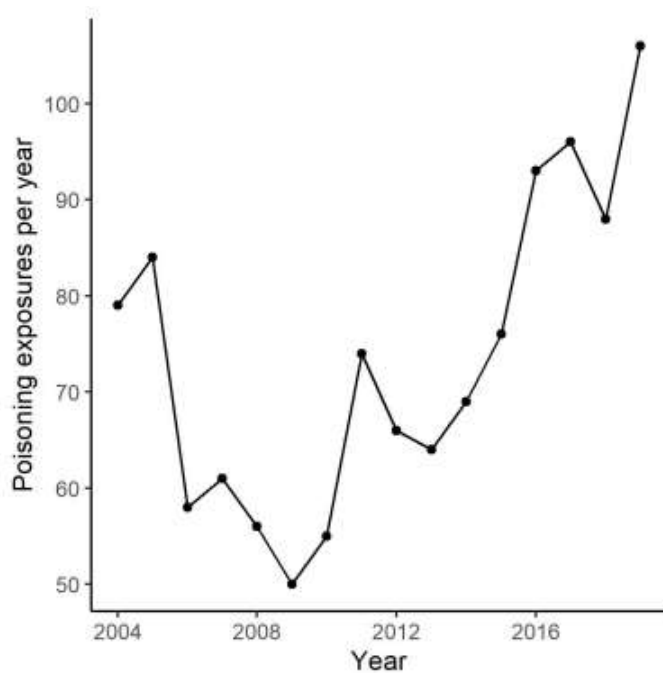


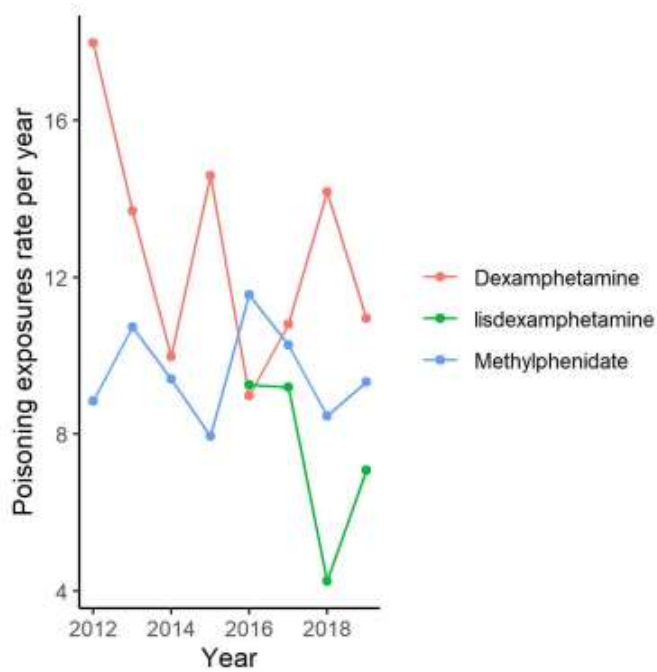

| Substance | N (%) |

| Dexamphetamine | 369 (32%) |
| Lisdexamfetamine | 62 (5%) |
